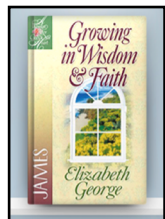


From the Choir Loft:

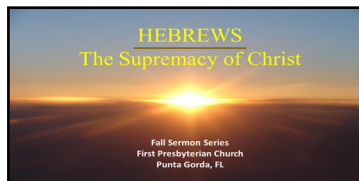

The Dunnemans

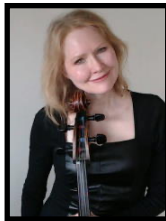

Matrick Thorpe and Ann Alton, Cellists

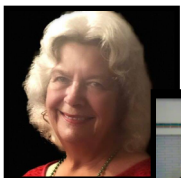

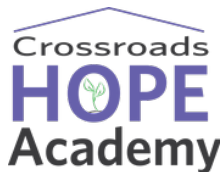

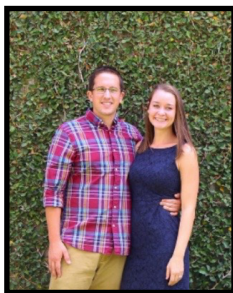
