SERMON NOTES

REFORMATION SUNDAY

Presbyterians, and other Protestant denominations, celebrate the tradition that grounds their faith on Reformation Sunday. It is always the last Sunday in October, marking the occasion in 1517 when Martin Luther posted his 95 theses on the church door in Wittenberg, Germany. The purpose of Luther's call for reform came to be known as the Five Solas, Latin for slogans: sola Scriptura (Scripture alone), sola fide (faith alone), sola gratia (grace alone), solus Christus (Christ alone), and Soil Deo Gloria (to the glory of God alone.) Luther sought to return the focus of faith back to the source of it ...Jesus.


John 11:17-27

¹⁷ Now when Jesus came, he found that Lazarus had already been in the tomb four days. ¹⁸ Bethany was near Jerusalem, about two miles off, ¹⁹ and many of the Jews had come to Martha and Mary to console them concerning their brother. ²⁰ So when Martha heard that Jesus was coming, she went and met him, but Mary remained seated in the house. ²¹ Martha said to Jesus, "Lord, if you had been here, my brother would not have died. ²² But even now I know that whatever you ask from God, God will give you." 23 Jesus said to her, "Your brother will rise in." ²⁴ Martha said to him, "I know that he will rise again in the resurrection on ast day." ²⁵ Jesus said to her, "I am the resurrection and the life. Whoever believes he, though he die, yet shall he live, ²⁶ and everyone who lives and believes in hall never die. Do you believe this?" 27 She said to him, "Yes, Lord; I believe you are the Christ, the Son of God, who is coming into the world."
